Scoreboard Sponsor Recognition

Program Description: Papillion-La Vista Schools Foundation has installed an LCD video screen next to the scoreboards in the competition gyms at Papillion La Vista and Papillion La Vista South High Schools to publicly recognize the District's closest relationships while enhancing the use of this space and creating an ongoing funding source for school athletics and Foundation student programs.

These LCD boards will show advertisements for community partners by placing a revolving message that will play throughout the years athletic and school events.

The Foundation will seek 30 sponsors for each high school (60 total) to support Papillion La Vista and Papillion La Vista South High Schools through an annual gift/pledge of \$800 for one school, and \$1,400 for rotating spots at both high schools. These ads will run at all varsity athletic contests for a one year time period and are renewable.

Traffic Estimates: Approximately 12,000 people attend events each year in each high school. We believe it both fitting and appropriate to highlight our closest community partners through Scoreboard Sponsor recognition.

Impact of the Community and District: Fully implemented, this project will create an immediate and sustainable source of revenue of over \$40,000 annually. It will help the athletic departments provide opportunities to students as well as provide the Papillion-La Vista Schools Foundation with ongoing funding for programs that provide students with the opportunities they would not receive any other way.
