

## **Papillion – La Vista Schools Foundation / Kids Club COVID-19 Plan and Parent Information**

At Papillion – La Vista Schools Foundation / Kids Club the health and safety of our children, family and staff is our top priority. The purpose of this communication is to share what steps the Papillion – La Vista Schools Foundation / Kids Club has taken and to ask for your support in helping us keep children, staff, families and community healthy and safe.

Please read carefully all the information so we can all work together to keep everyone safe.

### **Currently Papillion – La Vista Schools Foundation / Kids Club is:**

- Working closely with Papillion La Vista Community Schools in all communications, policies and guidelines.
- Working closely with Sarpy/Cass Health Department and following all requirements and guidelines from the CDC, DHHS and other government entities.
- Continue our current cleaning policies; disinfecting items and toys that are used or played with frequently. Increase disinfecting high touch area (door handle, light switches, tables, etc.).
- Additional hand washing education and signage for all Kids Club staff and children.
- To limit the number of persons and possible exposures, only children attending the program, Kids Club staff and vendors will be permitted into the building.
- Kids Club staff will assist in signing in/out the children by meeting all parties at the door they will then escort the children in or out of the building.
- Kids Club will enforce hand washing practices, including all persons must wash their hands upon entering the building.
- Kids Club will continue with the stringent hand washing care before each meal or snack, transitions from outside to inside or coming from school to Kids Club or Kids Club to school for all children and staff.
- Kids Club will assure that children are separated when eating.
- Both Children and staff will have their temperature taken and recorded upon arrival. This includes arriving for the morning and arrival from school in the afternoon. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher may not stay on the premises. Children and staff may not return until they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications. In some cases, a doctor's note may be required to return to the premises.
- All vendors will have their temperature taken before entering the building. A temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed in the building.
- All children must wear a mask while in the building. Masks breaks will be given, for example, when playing outside.
- Children will be sent home immediately if exhibiting fever, cough, difficulty breathing or any other COVID-19 symptoms.
- All Kids Club staff will wear a mask while caring for children. All special presenters/vendors will be required to wear a mask and adhere to social distancing.
