



\$2,000 MIDLANDS PLACE COMMUNITY-SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP **APPLICATION Presented by Wild Rice Sushi**

Scholarship eligibility and guidelines are as follows:

- To qualify for this scholarship, you must be a Senior graduating during the 2017-2018 school year from a school within the Papillion La Vista Community Schools, (either Papillion La Vista HS or Papillion La Vista South HS).
- **Applicants may only apply for ONE Midlands Place Scholarship**, (i.e. if you have applied for the Midlands Place scholarship through Ollie and Hobbes, you may NOT apply for the one offered by Wild Rice Sushi or any other Midlands Place tenant).
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Plan to attend either college or trade school during the Fall or Winter of 2018.
- Applications will be judged by a panel selected by Wild Rice Sushi and by the Papillion-LaVista School Foundation.

If you are interested, fill out the attached questionnaire and leave it with us, then complete the following steps **no later than March 10th, 2018:**

1. Complete a community service project during the 2017-2018 school year. The project should not be something that was completed prior to your application process.
2. Write a report on your experience and include the following information:
 - a. A detailed explanation of your community service project, including but not limited to:
 - i. How you came up with the idea for your project
 - ii. Steps you took to complete your project
 - iii. The results of your project and what you learned
 - b. You should also incorporate a summary of your post-secondary plans
 - c. Please include an official copy of your High School transcripts.
 - d. Feel free to include pictures of your experience as well!
3. Sample ideas are attached for you to refer to. The key is that it should be original to you, make a difference, and you have to be able to show the results.

***Only Seniors can apply but if you have a Junior, sign-up for emails to stay up-to-date on future scholarship availability! Final scholarship selection and awards will be made in the early part of April 2018.
